



Whitecap Dakota First Nation

Seniors On-Reserve Private Hospital Room Subsidy Program April 1, 2016 – March 31, 2017

Program:

- Provides a private or semi-private room to Whitecap Dakota First Nation (WDFN) Senior members who reside on-reserve and who are admitted into acute hospital care.

Eligibility:

- All WDFN Band Members 60 years of age or older; residing on-reserve who require 'physician ordered' hospital care admission.
- Dependent on private or semi-private room availability.
- Dependent on available funds through WDFN Health Services.
- To a maximum of ten (10) days in total within one calendar year.
- Does not include any additional hospital services.

Approval Process:

- All qualifying Band Members must provide either a written or verbal recommendation from the patient's primary physician stating that moving to a private room will be beneficial for the patient's care.
- All qualifying Band Members shall provide supporting documentation on age, date of birth etc. as required.
- A family member of the admitted Senior member shall contact the Health Centre during business hours only.
