Re: Public Service Announcement – Potential COVID-19 Exposure at Funeral in Whitecap on November 5, 2020

Please be advised of a potential COVID-19 exposure at the funeral which was hosted in Whitecap at the Charles Red Hawk Elementary Gym on **November 5, 2020 from 9 am – 3:30 pm** where a person(s) attended while likely infectious.

If you were in attendance at the funeral, we encourage you to stay home and **self-monitor**, even if you are not exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms. You will be contacted via phone from Public Health to inform you of next steps. If it is necessary for you to go out of your home, ensure you are wearing a mask, practice physical distancing, and wash or sanitize hands frequently. Self-monitoring means paying attention to your health so you can identify signs of sickness. A self-monitoring information sheet is attached to this notice.

Note: The Whitecap Testing Site is available to all WDFN Community Members and all employees who work in Whitecap, and is open from Monday-Friday, 9 am – 11 am, excluding holidays. Anyone who wishes to be tested can do so through the drive-up testing site at the Health Centre or by calling at 306-373-4600. Your health card is required at time of testing.
