

Whitecap Dakota Nation Election Code Summary and Revisions

Membership Meeting Vote September 5, 2024

Overview of Changes to Code:

- Updates to the Code were made after direction was received by the Membership at the Membership Meetings on June 17 and August 8, 2024
- The relevant changes include:
 - Inclusion of a definition for "**Corrupt Practices**" at Section 3
 - Reference to an "Election Regulations Act" which will be established under the Code to assist with the administration of the Code (Section 25)
 - Act will be introduced and shared with Membership in September for comment after Election Code is approved
 - Reference to "Rules of Candidates Conduct" that will be set out in Election Regulations Act
 - Follow WDN Laws and Values; Avoid Corrupt Practices
 - Allows for typical campaign activity such as meals and transportation
 - Updates to reflect inclusion and timing of **Candidates Forum**
 - Addition of Section 17: Candidate Conduct, which states that no candidate will engage in illegal, criminal, or Corrupt Practices, and states that every Candidate is expected to abide by the Rules of Candidate Conduct
 - Revision to **Declaration of Intent** to reflect Section 17
 - Grounds for Appeal at 23.2.2 includes illegal, criminal, or Corrupt practice on behalf of a Candidate
- Ballot structure remained the same (must vote for 4 Candidates)
- The requirement for 4 Councillors was already included in Governance Code, no change to Governance Code or Election Code required
